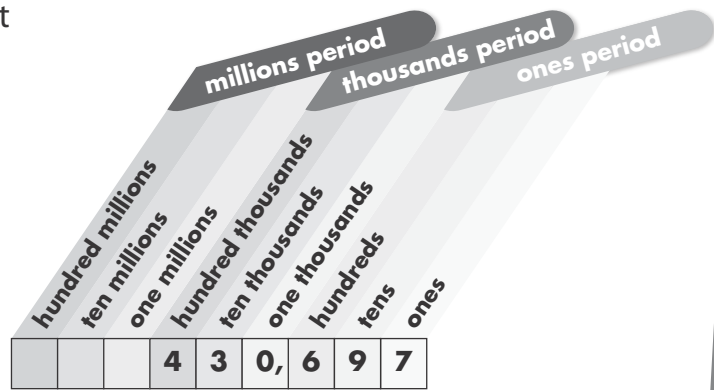


A-Z Vocabulary

2. The position of a digit in a number tells the value of the digit. This is called **place value**.

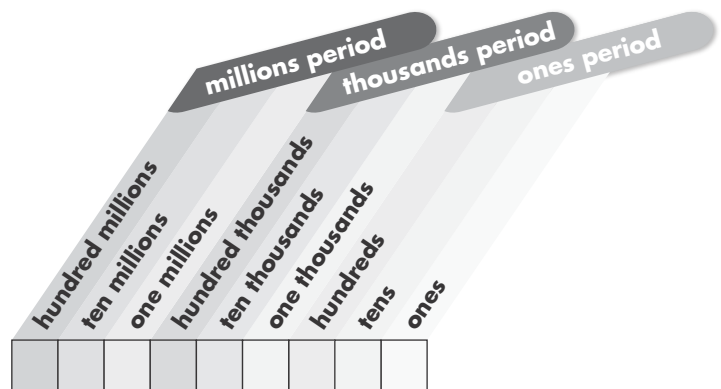
What is the value of the 6 in 430,697?
